


Bridging dreams to careers GENESIS LAB

While primarily targeting Fall-2022 fresh graduates and last semester students of FOC and FOMSS, the drive extended invitations to all graduating students and recent alumni. A total of 108 candidates registered online, with 79 participating in the initial interview and screening test. 

The Capacity Building Training Session covered a diverse range of topics crucial for the professional development of graduates. The training addressed key aspects such


02. Spring - 2023

Fall - 2022 (Batch 191)


A total of 15 trainings held with the graduating departments and 237 students benefited from training program.

SEMINAR & WORKSHOP





SEMINAR DRUG AWARENESS

CAMP


